

To Our Valued Customers,

We have been closely monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic. Our number one priority is the safety of our customers, employees, communities and rural areas we serve.

In an effort to serve our clientele and as we continue to monitor the requirements of government agencies, as well as the guidelines from the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), we have been implementing their recommendations as best possible to conduct the farm equipment and real estate auctions that have been scheduled and advertised to occur in these unsettling times.

We have made recommended cleaning procedures of our static office locations and of our mobile auction office/courtesy van. We have recommended cleaning procedures as part of our daily routine and have required all employees feeling sick to stay at home and contact their medical professional.

One of the ways to contain the spread of COVID-19 is to limit contact with others and time spent in public places, because of this we are not currently conducting any auctions in any public buildings.

At open air or outside auctions we are encouraging spacial distancing between attendees and are limiting direct contact in so much as possible between auction attendees and our staff. Hand sanitizers are located in restrooms and in the courtesy van. We also request that only those interested in certain pieces of equipment be in a nearby proximity to the item they are interested in bidding on and near the auction topper/auctioneer, ringmen and auction staff. For bidder registration we request no more than three registrants or buyers settling for items be in the courtesy van at one time.

Foremost, bidders at our Farm Equipment Auctions that are uncomfortable attending or those with compromised health, are encouraged to bid remotely online via PROXIBID – for convenience a link is located on the Front Page of Our Website at www.suttonauction.com

Bidders at our Land Auctions are requested to stay in their vehicles to participate and bid. Again, individuals that are uncomfortable attending are encouraged to contact us to arrange for remote phone bidding with a member of our auction staff.

Again, if you are not comfortable with attending our auctions or you feel ill, please feel free to contact us to arrange for alternative bidding procedures and for pickup of purchased items.

We want everyone to be as safe as possible while we continue to serve our customers. We thank you for your business, support and understanding during this rapidly evolving situation.
